MAJDI AL NASER from Saudi Arabia will present his program “Turning a Hobby Into a Profession” at 2:00pm, Sunday, February 25 at the Delaware Photographic Society. The presentation will be in Auditorium C at Cokesbury Village, 726 Loveville Road, Hockessin, DE 19707 and is free and open to the public.

In 1987, Majdi Al Naser began his photographic journey using a point-and-shoot camera. He eventually graduated to a Minolta SLR after discovering how much he loved photography. He is most interested in portrait and street photography. In 2013, he founded the Gulf Photographers Center, a club whose mission is to create a generation of professional photographers. In 2016 the club held its first international exhibition, the AFAN International Exhibition of Photography. Majdi serves as Photography Department Supervisor of the Saudi Arabian Society for Culture and Arts. In 2017, he completed the Professional Photography Course from The New York Institute of Photography. He is an active member of the Photographic Society of America.
